Safe Storage: Store lead acid batteries in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated area away from flammable materials. Keep batteries secured and prevent them from tipping, as this can cause ...

A dedicated, secure storage cabinet or room designed for batteries--preferably with fire-resistant materials--is ideal to contain risks and restrict unauthorized access.
